Communication Engineering, in view of the reduction in interest rates of fixed deposits thus leading to insufficient generation of funds for meeting the recurring & non-recurring expenditure related to the Chair.

- ii. Hon'ble Chancellor directed to ensure high quality research work is conducted under the auspices of the newly established Dr. C V Raman Chair in Physical Sciences.
- iii. Hon'ble Chancellor desired that National Education Policy 2020 (NEP 2020) be kept as the guiding policy for framing the Master Plan of the University for the next five years. In this context it was desired that:
 - a) University should adopt the major provisions of the NEP 2020, to the extent possible, from Academic Session 2021-22 itself
 - b) University must start the PG program in Vedic Studies from the next Academic Session 2021-22.
 - c) In view of the significant emphasis on Teacher training in the NEP 2020, a new School of Education be established under a new Faculty of Education, offering the relevant B.Ed. program, after obtaining approval of the relevant regulatory body. Students shall be admitted through university's own selection process. Faculty positions for the new School as under were also approved:

Professor: 01 Nos.

Associate Professor: 02 Nos.

Assistant Professor: 04 Nos.

It was also decided to amend the Statutes/Ordinance of the University

d) Universities of the UT of J&K should work towards Inter-University credittransfer policy, in line with the NEP-2020 at the earliest.

e) The enrollment of the Students be enhanced by offering new programs and by increasing the intake of the existing program in demand, in line with the

iv. Hon'ble Chancellor directed that the University must focus on enhanced Industry Collaboration. He also desired that the faculty members of the University must focus on obtaining more consultancy work. In this context, as advised earlier by Hon'ble Chancellor, Vice Chancellor informed that School of Architecture and Landscape Design along with School of Civil Engineering has prepared a proposal for approaching the Government of UT of J&K, for entering into an institutional MoU with Department of Public Works, for consultancy regarding their various projects.

v. With reference to the discussion on offering new programs in biosciences and environmental science, it was decided to establish the **Faculty of Earth & Environmental Sciences** consisting of

R. 16 Board of Examiners

A. After the successful defence of Pre-Ph.D. Synopsis of Ph.D. student, Supervisor of the Ph.D. student shall propose the Board of Examiners duly recommended by the SRC, for the evaluation of thesis of Ph.D. student. The Board will consist of the Ph.D. Supervisor(s) as Internal Examiner(s) and three External Examiners of which at least one will be from India and at least one from abroad. The panel of examiners for Ph.D. thesis evaluation recommended by School Research Committee (SRC) should not include, the name /names, of a person/persons, with whom the student has published her / his Research Paper / Papers. The supervisor shall obtain a list of publications including ones under review/communicated, from the student before submission of the proposal for panel of examiners. The supervisor shall also be required to give an undertaking to this effect (in the prescribed format) along with the list of Examiners. As far as possible, must ensure that the proposed Examiners (Foreign/ Indian) for evaluation of Ph.D. thesis should belong to Universities/ Institutes having been ranked in the 'The Times Higher Education World University Rankings' for Foreign Universities and among top 150 NIRF ranking for Indian Universities/ Institutions. Each of the examiners shall be expert in the subject of the thesis. These external examiners may be chosen by the Vice Chancellor from a list of 10 examiners

- (ii) After completion of last four semesters (seventh to Tenth semesters), the students will be awarded the Master's degree in (discipline name) subject to their completing all requirements.
- 4. The students will be required to communicate their intent to exit the program, in writing, prior to the completion of the 6thSemester of the program, failing which it will be assumed that they will be continuing with the program.
- 5. In case of availability of seats after the completion of the Bachelor's degree of the integrated program due to the exit of the students, fresh candidates shall be considered for admission to the Master's program (M.Sc./M.A./MBA) part of the integrated program.
- 6. On-going M.Sc./MBA/M.A. programs, in the above-mentioned disciplines will continue. However, the curriculum of these M.Sc./M.A./MBA program shall be the same as that of Semester 7, 8, 9 & 10 of the respective Integrated programs; thus, for the Master's degree component of the Integrated program and the relevant M.Sc./M.A./MBA program, the curriculum and class will be common from Session 2023-24 onwards.
- 7. A candidate who has passed the 10+2 examination from any recognized or equivalent thereto, shall be eligible for admission. The detailed eligibility conditions e.g. percentage of marks in the qualifying examinations, subject (s) combination etc. etc. shall be notified in the Admission Brochure as approved by the Academic Council from time to time. Candidates placed under compartment in the qualifying examination shall not be eligible for admission. Those who have done graduation or post-graduation in the same discipline, shall not be eligible for admission to the 5-year Integrated Courses.

Semester, if any do not count towards this.

- d. The CGPA & NSS requirements are the same as applicable for other Undergraduate programs.
- e. It is mandatory for the student to complete successfully each of the criterion mentioned at Points a-d (As applicable) above for award of degree. Failure to complete any one of the above requirements, within the maximum time period allowed for completion of degree program, will make the student in-eligible for award of Degree and his/her admission will be terminated and no degree will be awarded.
- 10. The relevant Academic Rules & Regulations, as applicable to students of other programs in the university, shall also be applicable to the students of the integrated programs.

2. Process of Personal Promotion

Various stages of promotions/ direct recruitment and mode of selection are given in Table 2. A teacher who wishes to be considered for promotion may submit in writing in the prescribed proforma as evolved by the concerned University / College duly supported by all credentials to the Principal / Director of the College, within three months in advance of the due date, that he / she fulfills all requisite qualifications. The entry level and consecutive stages of promotions are shown in Table 2

Candidates who do not fulfill the minimum requirement proposed in the Regulation, will have to be re-assessed after a period of one year. The date of promotion shall be the date on which he / she satisfies all the minimum requirements and successfully reassessed.

3. Constitution of Screening cum Evaluation / Selection Committees

The constitution of the selection committee as applicable to these appointments (direct recruitment) / promotions of the Assistant Professor to Associate Professor and Associate Professor to Professor or Professor to Senior Professor shall be as per Annexure – II of the above regulations.

4. Training Requirements for Promotions of Teachers

The Training requirements for promotion of Teachers from one stage to the other shall be as per details laid down under Annexure-III of the above Regulations.

5. Minimum qualifications for Recruitment & Promotion

Minimum qualifications, experience, research contributions, feedback and requisite training requirements for different levels for Direct Recruitment and Promotions for the faculty members of Engineering and Management discipline shall be as per details brought out under clause 5.1, 5.2, 7.1 and 7.2.1 of the above regulations.

In pursuance to Clause 2 of Chapter 38, "RECRUITMENT PROCEDURES & CONDITIONS OF SERVICE OF UNIVERSITY EMPLOYEES" of the University Statutes, the above qualifications being minimum in nature, in order to improve

quality, Ph.D. shall be a mandatory qualification for recruitment at all levels [Assistant, Associate or Professor level] and shall be mandatory for promotion to Associate Professor & Professor Level.

Also, for movement from Assistant Professor (Stage II) to Assistant Professor (Stage III) a minimum of 05 years of service in Level 11 shall be required in addition to the minimum criteria as laid therein, in the above regulations.

6. The Pay Scales, however, shall be as per UGC guidelines as is stated in Clause 6, sub-clause 6.1 of Chapter 38, "RECRUITMENT PROCEDURES & CONDITIONS OF SERVICE OF UNIVERSITY EMPLOYEES" of the University Statutes, which states that, "Pay scales for various categories of teachers, i.e., Assistant Professors, Associate Professors and Professors shall be as followed in the UGC system."

7. Incentives for Ph. D. and other Higher Qualification

Clause 2.22 of the above Regulations provide that;

(i) Five non-compounded advance increments shall be admissible at the entry level of a recruitee as an Assistant Professor possessing a Ph.D. awarded in a relevant discipline by the recognized University following the due process of admission test, course work and external evaluation as prescribed by the UGC or the admission process adopted by the institutes established under the Act of Parliament or students having valid GATE / GPAT score for admission to Ph.D. or students selected for Ph.D. program under National Doctoral Fellowship program of AICTE / Prime Minister's Research Fellowship program.

9. Counting of Past Service for Direct Recruitment and Promotion Clause 2.25 of the above Regulations provides the detailed norms for counting of past regular service of an Assistant Professor, Associate Professor or Professor.

10. Mandatory Teacher Trainings

Clause 4 of the above Regulations provides that;

- (i) Every teacher appointed / promoted to any position here onwards with effect from the publication of this gazette shall have to mandatorily undergo 8 online modules of MOOCs in SWAYAM as per the AICTE teacher training policy preferably within first year of service.
- (ii) No newly appointed faculty member shall be completing the probation without getting the certification of completion of these 8 modules. The teacher training policy document may be downloaded from AICTE website.
- (iii) The requirement of completing these modules as envisioned in this gazette is applicable to all the incumbent teachers also while applying for promotion / selection to next higher cadre only once in the career.
- (iv) Those who are eligible for promotions after the date of publication of this gazette, shall have to meet the necessary conditions such as additional qualification, undergoing industrial training, pedagogical training, faculty induction program, publishing research papers etc. However, these requirements shall be permitted to be fulfilled till 31st July, 2022 so as to enable faculty members in equipping them for requisite mandatory requirements of this gazette to avail the benefit of promotion retrospectively from the date of eligibility.

11. Age of Superannuation

The age of superannuation of all faculty members and Principals/Directors of institutions shall be 65 years.
