The World Outside..

Aditya-I is a scientific mission designed to study solar corona. The major scientific objectives of the proposed space solar coronagraph are to achieve a fundamental understanding of the physical processes that (a) Heat the solar corona (b) Accelerate the Solar Wind, and (c) Produce Coronal Mass Ejections (CMEs). The proposed design of the coronagraph instrument is aimed to understand High Frequency Intensity Oscillations (~1Hz), Dynamics of Coronal Loops with High Cadence, Magnetic Field Topology and CMEs close to the Solar Disk.
