paper, entitled, "Applying Ockham's Razor to (In)valid syllogisms using Venn-Peirce framework" in the 2<sup>nd</sup> International Workshop on the Philosophy of Notation, held at the University of Bologna, Italy, from 22-24 May 2019. The session was chaired by Prof. Atsushi Shimojima from Doshisha University, Japan, and the workshop was jointly organized by the University of Bologna (Italy) and University of Brighton (UK). The theme of the workshop was operational iconicity and observational advantages. These properties of logical notations seem to be inextricably linked and have been closely studied, but are still difficult to understand as stated by Mr. Sharma. The faculty member's research article, which had innumerable and priceless inputs from his supervisors,

Dr. A.K. Tewari and Dr. M.M. Chaturvedi, was deeply rooted in diagrammatic reasoning and presented a fresh overview of the theory of syllogisms. It was the only Indian contribution to the conference, and was appreciated by the congress for its rigor and novelty. Prof. D. Mukhopadhyay (Vice Chancellor, SMVDU) congratulated the team for its unstinting efforts to achieve excellence.
